I. THE WORKS: WHAT TO DO (Acts 17:16-21)

- A. GET BUSY WHILE YOU WAIT (16a; see 1Th.1:9,10; 3:11; 2Th.3:6f; see Mt.25:14f; 1Tm.6:17f)
- B. LOOK FOR OPPORTUNITIES (16b,22; see Mt.7:7f; Col.4:3)
- C. LET EVIL STIR YOU UP TO DO GOOD (16f,22f; see Eph.4:26,29f; Rom.12:9b,21)
- D. GO WHERE PEOPLE GATHER AND SPEAK TRUTH TO THEM (16; and do good to them, 14:8f)
 - 1. social situations: seek meaningful conversation (21; e.g., events, parks, retirement/nursing, hospitals, jails, etc.)
 - 2. engage in conversation with all kinds of church people (17a; see 1f,10f,etc.; Eph.4:14f)
 - 3. engage in conversation with all kinds of non-church people (17b,18; see 9:15; c.24-28!; Jn.4:1f)
 - 4. focus on the Gospel (18; see 3,31; Mt.28:18-20)
 - 5. forbear insults (18; 1Cor.1:22-24; see Acts 22:3; Phil.3:4f; see 2Cor.12:10; 1Pt.3:9; also Lk.15:2)
 - 6. seize the opportunities that seize you (19; see Prov.22:9; Dan.1:8-12 & c.2-6; 1Cor.9:19f)

II. THE WORDS: WHAT TO SAY (Acts 17:22-34)

- A. STUDY PUBLIC SPEAKING (22 & 33; see 21:40f; 23:1f; 24:10f; 26:1f; see Mk.13:11 w/2Tm.3:16,17)
- B. USE AN OUTLINE (22f; see c.7; Paul's speeches and letters)
- C. FIND SOMETHING THEY WANT THAT THE GOSPEL GIVES (22f; see 8:30f; see Eph.54321)
 - 1. bring it to their attention and promise an answer (22,23; see Jn.4:7f,16f)
 - 2. start w/basics of gen. revelation (see Rom.1:18f; Ps.19:1f /willful blindness, Mt13:15; Rm1:18f; 2Cor.4:4)
 - a. the doctrine of God: Creator & Provider, therefore Sovereign; Judge (24-26,31; 14:15,17; see Ps.33:6; 96:5; 100:3; 104:24f; 121:2; 124:8; 134:3; 136:5; 146:6)
 - b. the doctrine of man: unity / image (vs. idols) / relationship (26, Gen.c.1,5,10f / 28,29; Gen.1:26; Col.1:15 / 27-29; 1Th.1:9,10)
 - c. note: Jewish apologetic; Paul assumed in synagogues (see Is.44:9f; Dan.5:4,23; Habb.2:19)
- D. FIND SOMETHING THEY ALREADY BELIEVE THAT CONNECTS (28,29; see 2f; 18:28; Lk.24:27,32,45)
- **E. PROCLAIM GOD'S GRACE AND CALL TO REPENTANCE** (30; 14:16; 1Pt.4:3; Rom.2:4; Eph.2:11f; 3:1f; 1Th.1:9f; see Ex.34:6; Ps.86:15; 103:8; 145:8)
- F. PRESENT THE PERSON & WORK OF CHRIST (31,32; see Col.1:15f; Eph.2:1f)
- G. FORBEAR BAD INSULTS (32a; see Lk.6:26; 1Pt.4:12)
- H. EXPECT GOOD RESULTS (32b(see 11); 34 (see 4,12); see 1Cor.1:26)
