I. The 'why' of the Christian's reasonable service

- A. Who is Holy Spirit addressing in this Scripture
 - 1. The called of Jesus Christ beloved of God (Rom. 1:6-7; Heb. 3:1)
- B. God's direction to His saints is give Him their 'reasonable service'
 - 1. the definition of *service*
 - 2. the *reasonableness* of this service: the mercies of God (Rom. 1-11)

II. The 'what' of the Christian's reasonable service

- A. This inspired Scripture is the answer on the cry of each redeemed
 - 1. the details of this warmly entreated command
 - a. present your bodies
 - b. a sacrifice
 - c. a sacrifice with three descriptions: living holy acceptable unto God

III. The 'how' of the Christian's reasonable service

- A. The connection between vs. 1 and 2
- B. Spirit's main direction: be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind (2b)
 - 1. Fruit of transformation: *to undo and keep from conforming to this world* a. before regeneration, we all were conformed to the world (Eph. 2:1-3)

- b. now Holy Spirit calls us to 'stop conforming'
 - conformity to world is more in internal than external matter
- C. The details of this spiritual transformation by the renewing of your mind 1. It is an *ongoing* (*life-long*) transformation
 - 2. It is a passive transformation: it happens to us rather than done by us
 - 3. It is a *commanded* transformation: *involves our action* (Phil. 2:12-13)
- D. How does the Spirit accomplish this *transforming by the renewing of mind?*1. Through our efforts to *prove the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God*
 - 2. Why is it necessary to *study the BOOK*?
 - a. because you have with much baggage (Eph. 4:17-18)
 - b. because your conscience is misinformed (Eph. 5:7-10)
 - c. because it will make you less judgmental (Matt. 7:11-5)
 - d. because it will guide in *testing before tasting* (1 Thess. 5:19-21)

Finally: What is now the most important in our daily Christian living?
