INTRODUCTION: TWO POINTS OF FRICTION

Two points of friction emerge from John 6.

- 1. Jesus is teaching the people something that is difficult for them to understand.
- 2. Jesus is unwilling to teach the people in a way that might make it easier for them to understand.

The teaching throughout the passage is fairly simple. The problem we find is the dullness of the people to understand.

Mark 8:36

For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul? Strive for eternal things not temporary.

This is a not a foreign concept to the average Jew.

Psalm 16:11

You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
