

The Great Physician **Matthew 9:9-34**

Main Point:

As one who has been healed by the Great Physician, befriend the sick and bring them to Jesus for healing.

1. Jesus is the Great Physician who mercifully heals the sick.
2. As the Great Physician, Jesus raises the dead.
3. As the Great Physician, Jesus cleanses the unclean.
4. As the Great Physician, Jesus delivers those in the darkness.
5. As one who has been healed by the Great Physician, befriend the sick and bring them to Jesus for healing.

1 Timothy 1:15 ¹⁵ This *is* a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners ... (NKJV)

Romans 3:10-18 ¹⁰ As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; ¹¹ There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. ¹² They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one." ¹³ "Their throat *is* an open tomb; With their tongues they have practiced deceit"; "The poison of asps *is* under their lips"; ¹⁴ "Whose mouth *is* full of cursing and bitterness." ¹⁵ "Their feet *are* swift to shed blood; ¹⁶ Destruction and misery *are* in their ways; ¹⁷ And the way of peace they have not known." ¹⁸ "There is no fear of God before their eyes." (NKJV)

Ephesians 2:4-7 ⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ ... (NKJV)

Leviticus 15:19, 25 ¹⁹ `If a woman has a discharge, *and* the discharge from her body is blood, she shall be set apart seven days; and whoever touches her shall be unclean until evening ... ²⁵ `If a woman has a discharge of blood for many days, other than at the time of her *customary* impurity, or if it runs beyond her *usual time of* impurity, all the days of her unclean discharge shall be as the days of her *customary* impurity. She *shall be* unclean. (NKJV)

Numbers 5:1-3 ¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ² "Command the children of Israel that they put out of the camp every leper, everyone who has a discharge, and whoever becomes defiled by a corpse. ³ "You shall put out both male and female; you shall put them outside the camp, that they may not defile their camps in the midst of which I dwell." (NKJV)

Revelation 21:27 ²⁷ But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles ... (NKJV)

Acts 26:17-18 ¹⁷ I will deliver you from the *Jewish* people, as well as *from* the Gentiles, to whom I now send you, ¹⁸ to open their eyes, *in order* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.' (NKJV)

1 John 5:19b ¹⁹ ... the whole world lies *under the sway of* the wicked one. (NKJV)

Colossians 1:13-14 ¹³ He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (NKJV)

John 8:12, ¹² ... "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." (NKJV)

Luke 5:27-29 ²⁷ After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me." ²⁸ So he left all, rose up, and followed Him. ²⁹ Then Levi gave Him a great feast in his own house. And there were a great number of tax collectors and others who sat down with them. (NKJV)
