The Church As A Family:

- Entrance into the Family: New Birth
- Responsibilities to the Father...
 ✓ Love Him, Matt. 22:37-38; 1 John 2:15
 ✓ Honor Him, 1 Cor. 10:31; Rom. 15:5-6; John 5:23
 - ✓ Obey Him, John 14:31; Hebrews 12:9
 - ✓ Accept His Discipline, Hebrews 12:7-8, 10
 - ✓ Become like Him, 1 Peter 1:14-16;
 - 2 Cor. 6:16-7:1; 1 John 3:1-3.
 - ✓ Represent Him with honor, 1 Corinthians 15:15

The Church As A Family:

- Responsibilities to Each Other...
 - ✓ Recognize each other as brothers and sisters.
 - ✓ Love each other as brothers and sisters...
 - ✓ Honor each other as brothers and sisters
 - ✓ Live in unity with each other as brothers and sisters.

The Church As A Family:

- Responsibilities to Each Other...
 - ✓ Serve each other as brothers and sisters.
 ✓ Meet one another's needs as brothers and sisters
 - ✓ Refresh one another's hearts as brothers and sisters

The Church As A Body (1 Cor. 12:12-27) Responsibilities to Each Other...

- ✓ Recognize that this is God's doing...God's design, 12:11, 13, 18.
- ✓ Recognize our interdependence with one another, 14.
- ✓ Recognize that YOU are important, 15-20.

The Church As A Body (1 Cor. 12:12-27) Responsibilities to Each Other...

- Recognize that everyone else is important, too!, 21-24
- ✓ The goal is that there be NO DIVISION,
 25.
- ✓ Care for and honor one another, 25-26.
 ✓ Suffer and honor...together!, 26.

God wants us to live in the Church As a Family and As a Body With all of the blessings and responsibilities that each figure suggests!

Church Membership

- "Body Membership" in the universal Church is automatic and immediate upon salvation!
- Membership in a <u>local church</u> requires prior membership in the universal Church.
- Therefore, there may be conditions for becoming a member of a local church, to verify, first, among other things, that one is a believer, and is sound in doctrine.
