The Babylonian Captivity in Three Stages

- 1. Jehoiakim and Nobles (605 B.C.) First vessels taken. 2 Chronicles 36:5-7, Daniel 1:1-2, Isaiah 39:6-7, Jeremiah 27:1, 6-11.
- 2. Jehoiachin and the Rest of the Nobles (597 B.C.) More vessels taken. 2 Chronicles 36:9-10) Ezekiel 1:2-3, 2 Kings 24:12-15, Ezekiel 5:1-2, 8-13, 12:1-16.
- 3. Zedekiah Rebels (586 B.C.) Temple destroyed. 2 Kings 25:1-7, 2 Chronicles 36:14-21.

The Return from Captivity in Three Stages

1. Zerubbabel and Joshua the High Priest - Altar renewed, foundation of the temple laid. Ezra 1-6. Temple completed in 516 B.C., seventy years after its destruction.

[Several decades pass between Ezra 6 & 7. During this period, the events of Esther take place.]

- 2. Ezra, the Scribe Religious reform and spiritual renewal. Ezra 7-10.
- 3. Nehemiah Rebuilding of the walls. Nehemiah 1-13, Daniel 9:25.
