Upon Alamoth	"Maidens", sung by soprano voices.			
Upon Sheminith	"The eighth", perhaps a reference to a male choir.			
Upon Gittith	Winepress or Gititte instrument/melody.			
Upon Muth-labben	"Death of the son."			
Upon Aijeleth Hash-Shahar	"The hind of the morning"
