Daniel and His Friends (1-6)	
Mostly historical. Made up of six narratives.	
1 - A Divine Diet 2 - A Statue and Stone 3 - A Fiery Furnace	4 - A Tree in Turmoil 5 - The Heavenly Hand 6 - The Lions and the Lion-Hearted
Daniel and the Future (7-12)	
Mostly prophetic. Made up of four visions.	
7 - Godless Kingdoms and the Kingdom of God 8 - The Horns and the Heathen 9 - The Secret of the Seventy Sevens	10 - The Conflict Above the Clouds 11 - A Chronology of Ungodly Kings 12 - Closing Conditions
