Jesus confronted those who thought that being a physical descendant of Abraham made them right with God.

The contrast between Jesus’ opponents and Abraham was sharply drawn: Abraham was not a murderer, yet they sought to murder Jesus; Abraham obeyed and loved the truth, while they vehemently rejected it; Abraham welcomed God (Gen. 18:1ff), but they rejected Him (Heb. 1:1-2). No wonder Jesus said to them again, “You are not doing the deeds of your father.” The clear implication, as in verse 38, was that their father was neither Abraham nor God, but Satan (v. 44). - John MacArthur
