Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

Community Group Questions: Who would you really rather be, the man born blind forced to beg for a living whom Jesus then healed and who became His disciple but was "put out" or his respected social group, or the sighted men able to enjoy a seeing life who remained blind to the truth concerning Jesus but were allowed to "stay in" their peer group? If the former, why and are you living consistently with that reason? If the latter, why and how might life knowing and following Jesus in truth actually be better than the life you now enjoy?

"...Well, here is an amazing thing, that you do not know where He is from, and yet He opened my eyes. We know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is God-fearing and does His will, He hears him. Since the beginning of time it has never been heard that anyone opened the eyes of a person born blind. If this man were not from God, He could do nothing." John 9:30-33
