What is God like?

God has many amazing attributes.

God is...

- Creator
- Truth
- Eternal
- Self-existent
- Gracious

He is the Great I AM

- Wise
- Righteous
- Sovereign
- Holy
- Good

Today, we add a new one: Omnipotent

- Which means "all powerful"

There's a song called: I believe I can fly.

I believe I can fly

I believe I can touch the sky

I think about it every night and day

Spread my wings and fly away

I believe I can soar

I see me running through that open door

I believe I can fly

My children have changed the lyrics to: I believe I can die.

I just imagine someone jumping off a cliff, <u>flapping</u> their arms while <u>singing</u> "I believe I can fly" and <u>crashing</u> into the ground below.

There are a <u>lot</u> of things that we <u>can't do</u>.

We lack the ability.

But our God is **OMNIPOTENT**.

- OMNI all
- POTENT powerful

God is ALL Powerful.

He is <u>not limited</u> by **CAN**, but only by **WILL**.

He has the ability to do whatever he wants to do.

Psalm 115:3

Our God is in the heavens; he does all that he pleases.

Now, there are these **SILLY STATEMENTS** people make about God to confuse you.

Can God make a rock so big he can't move it?

No.

Can God make a pepper that is so spicy he can't eat it?

No.

There are some things that God can't do. He can't:

- Lie
- Do wrong or anything that goes against His character
- Cease to exist

But God can do whatever he desires to do.

He has all the power in the universe. --- He made the universe!

He is **BY FAR** the <u>most powerful</u> being in <u>existence</u>. He is a **MILLION TIMES** more powerful than **anyone** in <u>heaven</u> and anyone on <u>earth</u>.

Daniel 4:35

All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, But He does according to His will in the host of heaven And among the inhabitants of earth; And no one can ward off His hand...

<u>No one</u> in the host of heaven can stop God. There are mighty, <u>powerful angels</u> in even that could <u>squash</u> you like a <u>bug</u>. But none of them can stand up to the **All-Powerful God**.

SATAN, a guardian cherub, one of the most powerful created beings, because of his <u>pride</u> turned <u>against God</u> and brought <u>other angels</u> with him in his rebellion ... according to <u>Revelation</u> it seems that **1/3 of the angels** <u>followed</u> him. And God <u>threw</u> them <u>out</u> of heaven. They were <u>no match</u> for God.

Ezekiel 28:16-17 --- God speaking to the devil:

16 Through your widespread trade you were filled with violence, and you sinned. So I drove you in disgrace from the mount of God, and I expelled you, guardian cherub, from among the fiery stones.

17 Your heart became proud on account of your beauty, and you corrupted your wisdom because of your splendor. So I threw you to the earth; I made a spectacle of you before kings.

Here we see that **SATAN** was a very <u>beautiful</u> angel who became <u>proud</u> and <u>sinned</u> against God. So, God <u>chucked</u> him out of heaven.

At the <u>end</u> of the world, we see that the <u>earth</u> is just a <u>temporary</u> dwelling place for Satan. Ultimately, God will <u>throw</u> Satan into hell.

Revelation 20:10

And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur... [to] be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

The devil is no match for our Omnipotent God.

Satan can never go against God's sovereign will. Actually, God uses Satan for His purposes.

Martin Luther once said, "Even the devil is God's devil."

If God wants to do something no one can stop him. No one in heaven and no one on earth.

Back to Daniel 4:35

"All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing...

No one on earth can get in God's way: We could gather all our missiles, tanks, war ships, , airplanes and nuclear bombs. We could LAUNCH ALL THE FIRE POWER of the world against the thrown of God... and it would go DINK and fall to the ground.

It would be like throwing a cotton ball against mount Everest hoping to topple it.

In **Psalms 2**, <u>David puzzles</u> over how <u>foolish</u> people are to go <u>against God</u>. He asks the <u>question</u>: **Why?** Why would you ever try to <u>fight</u> against <u>God</u>?

Don't you know that God will just destroy you. It's not a fair fight. You don't have a chance.

Psalms 2:1-2

Why do the nations rage

and the peoples plot in vain?

The kings of the earth set themselves,

and the rulers take counsel together,

against the LORD?

Do you think God is scared when the kings of the earth plot against Him?

Verse 4 says: God laughs at them.

Psalms 2:4

He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord holds them in derision.

God is like: Is this a joke?

Imagine an ant waiving his fist at you. He yells up to you: "I'm going to take you down."

You'd laugh too. You'd say: "Is this a joke?"

The kings of this world take their stand against God, and he laughs. --- Is this a joke?

This is like a **FLEA** trying to attack an **EARTH MADE OF GRANITE**. The flea can <u>fly</u> as <u>hard</u> and as <u>fast</u> as he can against this massive <u>sphere</u> of rock-hard <u>granite</u>. But the granite <u>will not move</u>. **Zoooom** **DINK**.

What do we learn from this?

1st – It is very **FOOLISH** to fight against God. You are going to lose.

2nd – It is very **WISE** to pray to God. Because He is powerful. --- He can grant your requests. He can make it happen.

He is omnipotent. He can do whatever He wills to do.

We serve a **BIG God** who can <u>do</u> anything He <u>wants!</u>
