

Sharing Your Testimony

Acts 26:1-32

Main Point:

With boldness and suitability, share your testimony so that others would be saved too.

1. When sharing your testimony, explain who you used to be before Jesus saved you.

2. When sharing your testimony, tell the story of how and when Jesus saved you.

3. When sharing your testimony, relate how you have been changed for the better since Jesus saved you.

4. With boldness and suitability, share your testimony so that others would be saved too.

1 Peter 3:15 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; (NKJV)

Philippians 3:4-7 4 ... If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the flesh, I more so: 5 circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of the Hebrews; concerning the law, a Pharisee; 6 concerning zeal, persecuting the church; concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless. 7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. (NKJV)

Acts 22:16 16 And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.' (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 4:6 6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (NKJV)

Colossians 1:13 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, (NKJV)

Ephesians 1:7 7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace (NKJV)

Colossians 1:12 12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 5:13 13 For if we are beside ourselves, *it is* for God; or if we are of sound mind, *it is* for you. (NKJV)
