OUR GREAT HIGH PRIEST

Hebrews 4:11-16 & 5:1-10

- I. The Problem of Sin (4:11-13)—We are accountable to God
 - **A.** <u>The Danger of Disobedience</u> (4:1, 11)—it will keep you from entering God's rest, from reaching the goal, from receiving the promise
 - **B.** <u>The Word of God</u> (4:12)
 - 1. Its Function
 - a. It Warns ()—living and active
 - b. It Judges ()—sharp and piercing, discerning thoughts and intentions
 - 2. Its Focus
 - a. God sees the heart.
 - **b.** Sin *starts* in the heart.
 - c. The word of God addresses the heart.
 - C. The Omniscience of God (4:13)—all knowing; He sees everything!
 - 1. Nothing is <u>hidden</u> from God.
 - 2. We are <u>accountable</u> to Him. (Gen 3:4)
- **II.** The Priesthood of Jesus ()—He intercedes with God for humans.
 - A. Jesus' Excellent Credentials
 - **1.** He has <u>passed through the heavens</u>. (4:14)—His work on our behalf was accepted.
 - 2. He is the Son of God. (4:14; 5:5)—divine, well connected and able to pay
 - 3. He is fully human. (5:1-3; 2:17)—able to identify with and represent us
 - **4.** He was <u>appointed by God</u>. (5:4-6; Num 16-17)—*God chose Him* for this; therefore, God is pleased with Him, accepts His atonement on our behalf.

B. Jesus' Holy Character

- **1. He is Sinless** (4:15)
- **2.** He is Sympathetic (Heb 2:17-18; 4:15)
 - **a.** He has been <u>tempted</u>. (4:15; Mat 4:1; Lk 4:13)—in every way
 - **b.** He has suffered. (2:10; 5:7-9; Isa 53; Lk 2:51-52; Mat 3:14-15; Mat 5:10; 2 Tim 3:12)
 - c. He is able to deal gently. (5:2)
- C. Jesus' Priestly Services (4:16; 5:9)—
 - **1. He provides** mercy.—forgiveness for sins when we have fallen
 - 2. He provides grace. (2:18)—help when we are struggling
 - 3. He provides eternal salvation. (5:9)—
- III. The Confidence of Christians (4:16)
 - A. We have a **Great High Priest**. He cannot fail to secure mercy for us.
 - **B.** We have a <u>Sympathetic High Priest</u>. He is gentle and kind.
 - C. We can approach God boldly, without fear.
