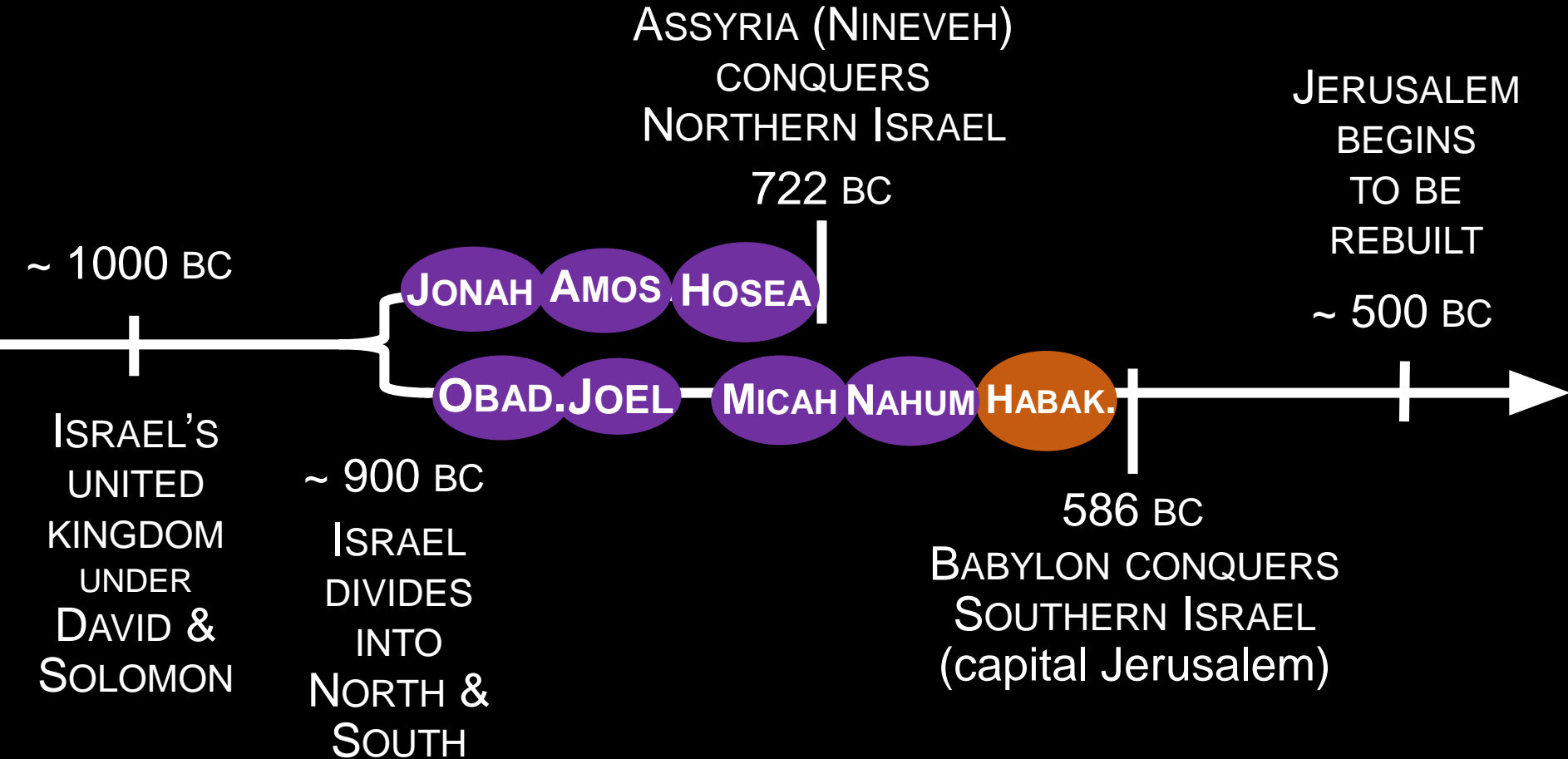

THE MAIN POINT OF HABAKKUK

God will eventually bring justice on Earth.

Right now, he calls everyone to live with faith,
waiting with joy till he fulfills his promises.

Four Ways Habakkuk Should Shape our Lives:

#1—Faith's Conviction

We must live with the conviction that
God will be glorified on earth.

Four Ways Habakkuk Should Shape our Lives:

#2—Faith's Crying

We can and should cry out to God
with our frustrations.

“O Lord, how long shall I cry for help
and you will not hear?”

— *Habakkuk 1:2*

Four Ways Habakkuk Should Shape our Lives:

#3—Faith's Constancy

We must continually trust God day by day
and never ever stop!

“The righteous shall live by faith.”

— *Habakkuk 2:4*
