# "Clans, Lands, Languages and Nations" Genesis 10

## **Prel Rmks**

Back to our study in Genesis ~ LOGW ~ read ... honor God ~ children

(1) Now this is the genealogy of the sons of Noah: Shem, Ham,

and Japheth. And sons were born to them after the flood. (2) The sons of Japheth were Gomer, Magog, Madai, Javan, Tubal, Meshech, and Tiras. (3) The sons of Gomer were Ashkenaz, Riphath, and Togarmah. (4) The sons of Javan were Elishah, Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim. (5) From these the coastland *peoples* of the Gentiles were separated into their lands, everyone according to his language, according to their families, into their nations. (6) The sons of Ham were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and Canaan. (7) The sons of Cush were Seba, Havilah, Sabtah, Raamah, and Sabtechah; and the sons of Raamah were Sheba and Dedan. (8) Cush begot Nimrod; he began to be a mighty one on the earth. (9) He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, "Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD." (10) And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar. (11) From that land he went to Assyria and built Nineveh, Rehoboth Ir, Calah, (12) and Resen between Nineveh and Calah (that is the principal city). (13) Mizraim begot Ludim, Anamim, Lehabim, Naphtuhim, (14) Pathrusim, and Casluhim (from whom came the Philistines and Caphtorim). (15) Canaan begot Sidon his firstborn, and Heth; (16) the Jebusite, the Amorite, and the Girgashite; (17) the Hivite, the Arkite, and the Sinite; (18) the Arvadite, the Zemarite, and the Hamathite. Afterward the families of the Canaanites were dispersed. (19) And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon as you go toward Gerar, as far as Gaza; then as you go toward Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, as far as Lasha. (20) These were the sons of Ham, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands and in their nations. (21) And children were born also to Shem, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder. (22) The sons of Shem were Elam, Asshur, Arphaxad, Lud, and Aram. (23) The sons of Aram were Uz, Hul, Gether, and Mash. (24) Arphaxad begot Salah, and Salah begot Eber. (25) To Eber were born two sons: the name of one was Peleg, for in his days the earth was divided; and his brother's name was Joktan. (26) Joktan begot Almodad, Sheleph, Hazarmaveth, Jerah, (27) Hadoram, Uzal, Diklah, (28) Obal, Abimael, Sheba, (29) Ophir, Havilah, and Jobab. All these were the sons of Joktan. (30) And their dwelling

place was from Mesha as you go toward Sephar, the mountain of the east. **(31)** These *were* the sons of Shem, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands, according to their nations. **(32)** These *were* the families of the sons of Noah, according to their generations, in their nations; and from these the nations were divided on the earth after the flood.

#### **INTRO**

**Genesis 9:1** So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.

Moses writing 550 years after the death of Noah, gives the genealogy of Noah and his sons and describes where they all had settled on the earth after Babel - chptr 11  $\leftarrow$  10

It is easy to recognize how this chapter is divided:

(1) Now this *is* the genealogy of the sons of Noah: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. And sons were born to them after the flood.

## I. The Sons of Japheth 2-5

Indo-Europeans – North and to the West and to the East in N. India

(2) The sons of Japheth were (3 Generations)

Gomer, Italy Magog, Russians

Madai, **Medo-Persians** (Esther) Javan, **Greece** 

Tubal, **Russians** Meshech, **Russians** 

Tiras.

(3) The sons of Gomer were

Ashkenaz, Riphath,

Togarmah.

(4) The sons of Javan were

Elishah, Tarshish,
Kittim, Cypriots Dodanim.

(5) From these the **coastland shoreline** (Mediterranean Sea and beyond ...), peoples of the Gentiles were separated into their lands country or territory, everyone according to his language native tongue, according to their families clans, into their nations people.

Apostle Paul traveled much of this territory – Apostle to the Gentiles [ ... ]

### II. The Sons of Ham 6-20

**Genesis 9:24-27** So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done to him. **(25)** Then he said: "Cursed *be* Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brethren." **(26)** And he said: "Blessed *be* the LORD, The God of Shem, And may Canaan be his servant. **(27)** May God enlarge Japheth, And may he dwell in the tents of Shem; And may Canaan be his servant."

Settled primarily in Africa and Mesopotamia

**(6)** The sons of Ham were **(4 generations)** 

Cush, Ethiopia, Arabia Mizraim, Egypt

Put, Libya Canaan Palestine

(7) The sons of Cush were

Seba, Havilah,

Sabtah, Raamah,

Sabtechah;

and the sons of Raamah were

Sheba Dedan.

- (8) Cush begot **Nimrod let us rebel**, **valiant** he began to be a **mighty one powerful one** on the earth.
- (9) He was a mighty hunter mighty in wickedness,

From someone who may have begun by taking large game in his hunts

To someone who captured men or conquered men

**Genesis 4:23-24** Then **Lamech** said to his wives: "Adah and Zillah, hear my voice; Wives of Lamech, listen to my speech! For I have killed a man for wounding me, Even a young man for hurting me. **(24)** If Cain shall be avenged sevenfold, Then Lamech seventy-sevenfold."

Nimrod was a tyrant – He was after personal glory – self-aggrandizement

He conquered, overpowered, and took control and power over people

He was the world's first emperor – that didn't take long!

**before the LORD**; therefore it is said, "Like Nimrod the mighty hunter **before the LORD**." **in the sight of God – in plain view of God** 

**Hebrews 4:13** And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things *are* naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we *must aive* account.

God sees what is happening in our nation – tyranny

Our focus must be in on prayer!

We can't do anything to bring our nation to repentance, BUT OUR GOD CAN!

(10) And the beginning of his kingdom was **Babel**, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

**Genesis 11:1-4** Now the whole earth had one language and one speech. **(2)** And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar, and they dwelt there. **(3)** Then they said to one another, "Come, let us make bricks and bake *them* thoroughly." They had brick for stone, and they had asphalt for mortar. **(4)** And they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top *is* in the heavens; **let us make a name for ourselves**, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth."

{Saban}

Not what we're here for!

- (11) From that land he went to Assyria and built **Nineveh**, Rehoboth Ir, Calah, (12) and Resen between Nineveh and Calah (that *is* the principal city).
- (13) Mizraim begot Ludim, Anamim, Lehabim, Naphtuhim,
- (14) Pathrusim, and Casluhim (from whom came **the Philistines** and Caphtorim).
- (15) Canaan begot **Sidon** his firstborn, and Heth;
- (16) the Jebusite, the Amorite, and the Girgashite;
- (17) the Hivite, the Arkite, and the Sinite; (18) the Arvadite, the Zemarite, and the Hamathite. **Afterward** the families of the Canaanites were **dispersed spread abroad**.

These are the people God told the children of Israel to "utterly destroy" (Deuteronomy 7:2).

- (19) And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon as you go toward Gerar, as far as Gaza; then as you go toward Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, as far as Lasha.
- **(20)** These *were* the sons of Ham, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands *and* in their nations.

## III. The Sons of Shem 21-31

(21) And *children* were born also to Shem, the father of all the children of **Eber**, **Hebrews** 

the brother of **Japheth the elder** the older brother of **Japheth**.

**(22)** The sons of Shem *were* (5 generations)

Elam, Asshur, Assyria – large empire

Arphaxad, Lud,

Aram **Syrians** 

(23) The sons of Aram were

Uz, Hul,

Gether, Mash.

(24) Arphaxad begot Salah,

and Salah begot Eber to pass over

**(25)** To Eber were born two sons:

Peleg, **division** for in his days the earth was divided;

and his brother's name was Joktan.

(26) Joktan begot

Almodad, Sheleph,

Hazarmaveth, Jerah,

(27) Hadoram, Uzal,

Diklah,

(28) Obal, Abimael,

Sheba, (29) Ophir,

Havilah, Jobab.

All these *were* the sons of **Joktan**.

- **(30)** And their dwelling place was from **Mesha** as you go toward Sephar, the mountain of the east.
- **(31)** These *were* the sons of Shem, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands, according to their nations.

#### **Summary:**

(32) These *were* the families of the sons of Noah, according to their generations, in their nations; and from these the nations were divided on the earth after the flood.

## **Implications / Applications**

  - 70 elders of Israel
  - Sanhedrin
  - Forgiveness 70 x 7
  - Jesus sent out 70 others
