Psalm 112:4

Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; *He is* gracious, *and full of compassion*, and righteous.

3. GOD IS MERCIFUL TO EXTEND MERCY TO ONE G______ AFTER ANOTHER

Psalm 145:8

The LORD *is* gracious and *<u>full of compassion</u>*, Slow to anger and great in mercy.

4. GOD IS MERCIFUL TO D_____ WITH H_____ HISTORY KINDLY

*Psalm 145:9

The LORD *is* good to all, And *<u>His tender mercies</u> are* over all His works.

5. GOD IS MERCIFUL TO INVITE SINNERS TO R_____

Joel 2:13

So rend your heart, and not your garments; Return to the LORD your God, For He *is* gracious <u>and merciful</u>, Slow to anger, and of great kindness; And He relents from doing harm.

6. GOD IS MERCIFUL TO S_____

Jonah 4:2

So he prayed to the LORD, and said, "Ah, LORD, was not this what I said when I was still in my country? Therefore I fled previously to Tarshish; for I know that You *are* a gracious and *merciful* God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm.
