V. THE BLESSINGS OF CONFESSION

- A. CONFESS THE TRUTH TO GOD, IN CHRIST, BY THE SPIRIT, ACCORDING TO THE SCRIPTURES & BEFORE THE WORLD! (Dn9:4f; Mt10:32; Rom10:4; 9,10; 1Cor12:3; Phil2:11; 1Tm3:16)
- **B. CONFESS CHRIST & BE CONFESSED!** (Mt.10:32-39; 26:64ff; Heb.12:2)
- **C. CONFESS YOUR SIN & BE FORGIVEN!** (Lev5:5f,10; 1K8:33,35; Ps32:5,1f(soon!); Prv.28:13; 1Jn1:9; 2:4; note:cup)
- D. CONFESS HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS & BE SAVED! (Rom. 10:4; 9,10; see Mt. 10:32; note: bread)
- E. CONFESS HIS GLORY & BE BLESSED! (Psalms!; see Rom.1:18-23; Heb.13:15, Lit., confess)
- **F. HOLD FAST YOUR CONFESSION!** (Heb.4:14; 10:23 /Mt.10:22(32,33); 24:13 /Mt.16:16/26:69f /2Tm.2:12f)

The Vows of The Covenant of Church Membership

- 1. We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be the Word of God, the only infallible rule for faith and life. Do you?
- 2. We believe in the one living and true God Father, Son and Holy Spirit, as revealed in the Scriptures. **Do you?**
- 3. We repent of our sin; confess our guilt and helplessness as sinners against God; profess Jesus Christ, Son of God, as our Savior and Lord; and dedicate ourselves to His service. We promise to endeavor to forsake all sin, and to conform our life to His teaching and example. Do you?
- 4. We promise to submit in the Lord to the teaching and government of this church as being based upon the Scriptures and described in substance in the Constitution of the Reformed Presbyterian Church of North America. We recognize our responsibility to work with others in the church and we promise to support and encourage them in their service to the Lord. In case we should need correction in doctrine or life, we promise to respect the authority and discipline of the church. Do you?
- 5. To the end that we may grow in the Christian life, we promise that we will diligently read the Bible, engage in private prayer, keep the Lord's Day, regularly attend the worship services, observe the appointed sacraments, and give to the Lord's work as He shall prosper us. **Do you?**
- 6. We purpose to seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness in all the relationships of life, faithfully to perform our whole duty as a true servant of Jesus Christ, and seek to win others to Him. *Do you?*
- 7. We make this profession of faith and purpose in the presence of God, in humble reliance upon His grace, as we desire to give our account with joy at the last Great Day. Do you?
