

## Answers Part 5

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**Question:** Please explain the Trinity.

### Deuteronomy 6:4

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God *is* one LORD:

### Genesis 1:26

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

### Isaiah 48:16

Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there *am* I: and now the Lord GOD, and his Spirit, hath sent me. Son is speaking referring to the Father and Spirit.

### Matthew 3:16-17

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: <sup>17</sup> And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

**Question:** A tract says it does not matter which religion you are to be saved. Do they get punishment or less blessings if they belong to a false religion?

### Isaiah 64:6

But we are all as an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

### Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

### 2 Corinthians 6:14 & 17

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? ... <sup>17</sup> Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you,

**Question:** At what part in the time frame did people not believe in God?

### Romans 1:21

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

**Question:** Explain Abraham and Sarah's laughs (Gen. 17:17; Gen. 18:12). Were they of joy or disbelief? What about Zacharias' disbelief?

### Genesis 17:17

Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a *child* be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

### Genesis 18:12

Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?

**Question:** Was it ok that Abraham had servants he bought with money? (Gen. 17:12-13 & 27; Ex. 21:2 & 7)

### Philemon 1:15-16

For perhaps he therefore departed for a season, that thou shouldest receive him for ever; <sup>16</sup> Not now as a servant, but above a servant, a brother beloved, specially to me, but how much more unto thee, both in the flesh, and in the Lord?

**Question:** Explain Galatians 2:17-19

But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, *is* therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid. <sup>18</sup> For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor. <sup>19</sup> For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.

### Galatians 2:12b

...he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.

**Question:** Explain "faith without works is dead."

### James 2:14-17; 21

What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith save him? <sup>15</sup> If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, <sup>16</sup> And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit? <sup>17</sup> Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. ... <sup>21</sup> Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?

### Genesis 15:6

And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

### Romans 3:28

Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

**Question:** Where did our sin that Jesus took go? Satan's inbox?

### Psalms 103:12

As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.
