THE KEYS OF GOD'S KINGDOM (2)

I. Who owns these keys? II. Who are called to use these keys?

III. How are these keys to be used?

III. How are the key of *preaching of the Gospel* to be used?

- A. The apostle's example (Acts 13) is our direction
- B. Paul first opened access to King and all His benefits to all (vs. 38)
 - 1. To whom did Paul preach the immediate and complete pardon of sins?
 - 2. Undoubtedly it was as hard to believe then as it is now
- C. Paul secondly opened the treasures of covenant of grace to believers (39)
 - 1. Paul proclaims (declares) the forgiveness of sins in Name of God
 - 2. This 'key' every ordained preacher is authorized to use (Acts 10:43; John 20: 23; Matt 16:19; 18; Acts 26:16-18)
 - 3. But it opened only to all and every believer in God and His Son Jesus (39)
- D. Paul thirdly closed the 'kingdom blessings' from unbelievers
 - 1. It began with a severe warning about being locked out: vs. 40-41, 45
 - 2. Ended with a 'condemning declaration to all unbelievers' (vs. 46 & 51!) a. Notice where these *ungodly people* were found? (vs. 44)
 - 3. God's sentence to all *unconverted* is solemn: Is. 3:11; John 3:18b; 3:36b a. to be *unconverted* is to be disobedient to God's command: Acts 3:19
 - b. stop soothing your sleepy conscience with fantasy thinking

- Conclude: God's market of free grace has a closing date (Is. 55:6; 1 Cor. 15:24)
- A. Today God's ambassadors still implore you (2 Cor. 5:20): but what if you receive God's grace in vain? (2 Cor. 6:1)
- B. How will God judge the unconverted in this life already?
 - 1. He will abandon you to yourself: Acts 13:40-41 Matt. 13:14-15
- C. How will God judge this in the life to come?
 - 1. He will reveal His long-held-back anger (Rev. 6:16-17; Rom. 2:5-11)
- D. We all stand before the same judgment seat: 2 Cor. 5:10
 - 1. Many witnesses will condemn you: John 5:45; Luke 17:31; Heb. 13:17
 - 2. But one witness will be the worst: Rev. 1:5
- E. Time is (very) short and your Judge stands before your door also (James 5:9)
 - 1. Hasten while He tarries in His longsuffering: 2 Peter 3:9
 - 2. Doubt not that He whom ye have slain with unbelief is still ready today to give you a new beginning: for there is forgiveness with Him!

Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and for ever (Heb. 13:8)
