		3) "To the church of the firstborn": Christ is THE firstborn, but we arew/ Him as firstborn
		True members of the church are enrolled in heaven, our names written in the Book of Life
		4) "To God the Judge of all": this is the 4th in the list of 7—the center, the of the passage
		a) Jews dreaded coming to God at Mt. Sinai: they could not approach Him w/out blood
		b) Under the New Covenant we can come to God on His throne for help because of Jesus
		5) "To the spirits of just men made perfect": Heb.11 is the Hall of Faith filled with of the OT
		a) Hebrew Christians had a community with these OT heroes, pictured in Rev. 4-5 by the 24
		b) After death, saints are unembodied clothed in Christ's righteousness, in a perfect state
