- **B.** Funds "that nothing be wanting unto them"
- C. Fruit "that they be not unfruitful"

III. Enjoy – "Greet them" (v. 15)

Enjoyment of the:

- A. Leaders "All that are with me salute you"
- **B.** Lovers "that love us in the faith"
- *C. Lord* "Grace be with you all"
