HOW TO TRANSFORM YOUR MIND

I. WHAT ARE THE **REASONS** FOR TRANSFORMING YOUR MIND? (12:2a)

“17 This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind,

18 having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart;

19 who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

20 But you have not so learned Christ,

21 if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus:

22 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,

23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind,

24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.”

Ephesians 4:17-24

A. To not be like the world by putting off the **old** way of thinking (vs 20-22).

1. **Futile** thinking (v17).

2. **Darkened** thinking (v18).

3. **Lewd** thinking (v19).

B. To be like Jesus by putting on the **new** way of thinking (v24a).

1. **Righteous** thinking (v24b).

2. **Holy** thinking (v24c).

II. WHAT ARE THE **RESOURCES** FOR TRANSFORMING YOUR MIND? (12:2b)

“Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.”

II Corinthians 4:16

A. **Salvation**.

“14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one.

B. **Spirit**.
