Gospel of John [A Daring Claim (Part 1) (John 10:22-31)]

I. The Occasion of the Daring Claim (vs. 22, 23)
II. The Occurrence of the Daring Claim (vs. 24-30)
-Jesus' miraculous works bear witness to His Messianic identity (v. 25).
-Jesus' hearers don't believe because they are not of Christ's sheep (v. 26). Christ's sheep believe in their Shepherd (v. 26); follow their Shepherd (v. 27); are known by their Shepherd (v. 27); receive eternal life from their Shepherd (v. 28); are protected and preserved by their Shepherd (vs. 28, 29).
-Jesus and the Father are one (v. 30): in essence, nature, and purpose.
III. The Outcome of the Daring Claim (vs. 31-42)
Practical Lessons
1) The blessings of God's people are precious beyond comprehension.
2) The blessings of God's people belong only to those who persevere in holiness and good works.
3) The blessings of God's people are freely given to all who respond to the voice of the Shepherd in faith and obedience
