## "Obedience Is Proof of Life in God" (1 John 2: 3-6)

- Something had raised the issue of the assurance of salvation
- John is addressing this issue as he writes to the church


## 1. The Group of Professing Believers Who Left the Church

- Vs 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but they went out that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us."


## 2. What the False Teachers (who had left the church) Were Saying

1:6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie
$1: 8$, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves."
1:10, "If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar."
2:4, "He who says 'I know him' but disobeys his commandments is a liar."
2:6 He who says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked

2:9 He who says he is in the light \& hates his brother is in the darkness still 4:20, "If any one says 'I love God' and hates his brother, he is a liar."

## 3. Exposition: Three Stages

1. Connection between knowing Christ \& obeying his commandments
2. Assurance that you truly know Christ if you obey his commandments
3. Anyone who says he abides in Christ will walk as Christ walked
