

## When Christians Neglect Spiritual Care, Part 2

We neglect spiritual care...

**13. When we don't know that we have a role (Eph. 4:12, 16).**

The kind of \_\_\_\_\_ that comes from God is the kind that involves *everyone*.

A church glorifies God when *everyone* is providing \_\_\_\_\_.

**14. When we are afraid about handling the burdens of others (Gal. 6:2).**

We can remember that we're not God (1 Pet. 5:6).

We can practice casting our anxieties on the Lord (1 Pet. 5:7).

We can believe that God can \_\_\_\_\_ to bear the burdens of others (1 Pet. 4:11).

We can believe that bearing the burdens of others is a high calling (Gal. 6:2b).

We can remember that long-term spiritual care is very valuable (Matt. 28:20; Heb. 13:5).

**16. When we are at our capacity.**

Remember that there is nothing wrong with being \_\_\_\_\_ (Ps. 103:14).
