## Grown-Ups In The Room Pt.25: “Shut Up And Learn Something.”

### **I Text:**

Old Covenant: *Deuteronomy 6:1-9, 20-26*

New Covenant: *1Peter 5:5-9*

### **II Doctrine:**

Peter exhorts young believers to obey and listen to their elders in the Lord. Moreover everyone in the covenant community is to fulfill their calling in the Lord. Those in leadership roles are to communicate Christian teaching worth listening to. Groups called “Churches” must never cater to a persons pride.

Humility is the best medicine for a Christian who needs their faith refreshed. Let God know in your prayers, you trust in his sovereign hand. God asks us to be spiritually mature, so he can promote and use us when needed.

Christians must be pushed to maturity in the faith. We must live a spiritually productive life, safe in the arms of god. The Devil like a lion, only attempts to feed on the weak link in the flock. Don’t be the weak link in your family, or congregation. Obey and teach the laws of Jesus Christ, no matter what the cost.

3) Christians must be pushed to maturity in the faith. We must live a spiritually productive life, safe in the arms of god. The Devil like a lion, only attempts to feed on the weak link in the flock. Don’t be the weak link in your family, or congregation. Obey and teach the laws of Jesus Christ, no matter what the cost. The shield of faith is your ultimate defense. (*1Peter 5:8,9; Mark 14:32-42; Ephesians 6:10-17*)

*Transliteration: tapeinoó*

*Phonetic Spelling: (tap-i-no'-o)*

*Definition: to make low, to humble*

*Usage: I make or bring low, humble, humiliate; pass: I am humbled*
