I. COVENANT GROUNDS for the BLESSING

FINAL ATONEMNT OF SIN FOR GOD'S SPIRITUAL ISRAEL HAS BEEN PROVIDED.

<u>Heb. 1:3</u> "Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;"

<u>Heb.2:17</u> "Wherefore in all things it behooved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people."

<u>Heb.7:27</u> "Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself."

Jhn.19:30 "IT IS FINISHED".

Rom.3:23-15 "23For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; 24Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:25Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins..."

II. CROWNING BLESSING of the NC

THE CESSATION (Ceasing) OF REMEMBERING THE SINS OF GOD'S SPIRITUAL ISRAEL.

<u>Heb.10:3-4</u> "But in those sacrifices (OC) there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins."

<u>Heb.10:12,14</u> "But this man (JESUS), after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;.... For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified."

> LORDS SUPPER & OUR NC WORSHIP.

The posture of our hearts during the Lords Table is one of great *HUMILTY* and *GRADITUDE*.

Humble – because we know its but by Jesus' blood we are pardoned. *Grateful* – because we know who we are and what our sins truly deserve.

> A CONSCINENCE AT PEACE WITH GOD.

Rom.4:14-15 "For if they which are of the law be heirs (Justified), faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: Because the law worketh wrath..."

➤ The Byproduct of knowing that <u>because of Jesus' Cross-Work</u>, GOD WILL NEVER REMEMBER OUR SINS is: our consciences are scrubbed and cleansed.

<u>Heb.10:22</u> "22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised;"

<u>Eph.5:27</u> "...presents to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish."

1John 1:9 "if we confess our sin, he is faithful and just to forgive our sin and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
