## **AM WORKSHEET**

Title: "That I May Dwell Among Them" | Text: Exodus 25:1-9 Intro

- The Law has been given, ch 20;
- The Law has been *applied*, **chs 21-23**;
- The Law has been *ratified*, **ch 24**;
- Moses is called into the Lord's immediate Presence to be w/Him for 40 days & 40 nights, ch 25:
  - The Lord announces that He will dwell among His people.
  - He calls for an offering to be taken for His dwelling-place.
  - His people are to be involved—following the pattern given to Moses.
  - The tabernacle, its furnishings & courtyard, its priesthood & services foreshadow the Person & Work of Christ Jesus our Lord.

Key Thought: What are we willing to give to the LORD that others may see Him at work in us & among us?

## 1A "(LET THEM) BRING ME AN OFFERING," vv1-6

1B The call to take up an offering for the Lord's tabernacle, vv1, 2a

**2B** The *conditions* of the offering, v2b

**3B** The *contents* of the offering, vv3-7

## 2A "LET THEM MAKE ME A SANCTUARY," vv8, 9

**1B** God's people are to be involved in building up the Lord's tabernacle, v8a

2B God's people are to follow the pattern given to Moses by the Lord, v9

## 3A "THAT I MAY DWELL AMONG THEM," v8b

**1B** The Lord intends to dwell *upon His earth* 

2B The Lord intends to dwell in the camp of His people, not outside it
