Title: The Furnishings In the Tabernacle Point Us To Christ Jesus | **Text:** Exodus 25:21-40

Key Thought: Mercy, Bread, & Light are key concepts in the Tabernacle. God will teach His people certain truths about their coming Redeemer, Christ Jesus, thru the symbolic meaning of the furnishings in the Tabernacle.

1A THE BLOOD ON THE MERCY SEAT, vv21, 22

1B Christ's atoning blood was sprinkled on the mercy seat *in heaven*

2B Points us to Christ's *all-sufficient & everlasting* atonement for God's elect

3B That mercy seat upon the Ark is *situated in the Most Holy Place* of the Tabernacle

2A THE BREAD ON THE TABLE OF SHOWBREAD, vv23-30

1B "Showbread" is a bread put on display to symbolize *God's ever-present care for His people*

2B Christ is the "Bread" from heaven *sent to save & to care for His people*

3A THE LIGHT ON THE GOLD LAMPSTAND, vv31-40

1B The seven lights on the lampstand were to *illuminate* the Tabernacle, v37

2B The seven lights on the lampstand were *never to go out* (Lev 24:1-4)

3B Christ Jesus is the "*Light of the World*" and the "*Light of Life*" (Jn 8:12)

4B The churches that belong to Christ are like the lights on the Gold Lampstand (Rev 1:20)
