- <sup>33</sup> "Hear another parable. There was a man, a house-master, such as planted a vineyard, and put a wall around it, and dug a winepress in it, and build a tower, and rented it out to tenant farmers, and went on a journey.
- <sup>34</sup> "And when the season for the fruits drew near, he sent his slaves to the tenant farmers, to receive his fruits.
- <sup>35</sup> "And the tenant farmers took his slaves, and one they beat, and one they killed, and one they threw stones at.
- <sup>36</sup> "Again he sent other slaves, more than the first ones; and yet they did to them likewise.
- <sup>37</sup> "But afterwards he sent to them his son, saying, 'They will show respect for my son."
- <sup>38</sup> "But the tenant farmers, when they saw the son, said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Over here! Let us kill him, and let us have his inheritance!"
- <sup>39</sup> "And they took him, and<sup>2</sup> they threw *him* out of the vineyard, and they killed *him*.
- <sup>40</sup> "Therefore, when the lord of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenant farmers?"

- <sup>41</sup> They say to Him, "*Those* bad *men*, badly will he destroy them, and the vineyard he will rent out to other tenant farmers, such as will repay to him the fruits in their seasons!"
- <sup>42</sup> Jesus says to them, "Did you never read in the Scriptures, 'The stone which the builders rejected, This became as the head of the corner; This came about from the Lord, and it is marvelous in our eyes"?<sup>3</sup>
- <sup>43</sup> "On account of this I say to you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you, and will be given to a nation bearing<sup>4</sup> its fruits.
- <sup>44</sup> "And he who has fallen on this stone will be dashed to pieces, and on whoever it falls, it will scatter him as dust." <sup>5</sup>
- <sup>45</sup> And when the chief priests and the Pharisees heard His parables, they knew that He is speaking concerning them.
- <sup>46</sup> And, though seeking to seize Him, they were afraid of the crowds, since they were regarding Him as a prophet.
