- **3.** Legalism is not equivalent to the usage of STRONG LANGUAGE when addressing serious doctrinal problems. (1:8-9)
- 4. Legalism is not equivalent with the proper recognition and exercise of AUTHORITY. (1:1, 17)
- 5. Legalism is not the equivalent of making scriptural judgments like calling people FALSE BRETHREN when they trust in Christ plus. (2:4)
- 6. Legalism is not equivalent to a PERSONAL CONFRONTATION OVER DOCTRINE OR SIN when biblically warranted and done for the upholding of God's Word and the person's good. (2:11-14)

- 8. Legalism is not equivalent to a PUBLIC EXHORTATION OR REBUKE by a pastor. (3:1-3

- **11.** Legalism is not equivalent to the pastor / teacher having a NEGATIVE TONE or EMPHASIS when needed. (4:20)
