Jesus Wept (Again)

Luke 19:28-44 Pastor Phil Winfield December 14, 2014

What happened on day one of Jesus' final week before His sacrifice?

- 1) Jesus Took **Control** v.28-35
 - a. Jesus arrived to Jerusalem by **Sovereign design** (v.28) *Ac 2:23; Ps* 118:22
 - b. Jesus had **sovereign control** of all of nature. V.29-34
- 2) Jesus received the **identifying praise**. V.35-40
 - a. They raised their voices in praise for all the works... v.37
 - b. They raised their voices in **expectation**. V.38.
 - c. The religious leaders raised their voices in **objection** (V.39-40). Blasphemy!
- 3) Jesus wept at the **<u>sight</u>** of Jerusalem. v.41-44
 - a. Jesus wept because they didn't **seize their opportunity** v.42!
 - b. Jesus wept because they missed out **on peace** v.42.
 - c. Jesus wept because of **coming destruction** v.43-44.

Jesus' love is undeniable.

- His **love** is constant (tears)
- his <u>invitation</u> is constant (your time, your peace, your visitation) -
- His **warning** is constant you and your children will be leveled.

Repent or perish is still the message!
