The Temptation and Fall of Man Genesis 3:1-7

Main Point:

Since you have become a covenant-breaker in Adam, you need Jesus Christ because He makes you a covenant-keeper in Him.

1. God entered into a covenant relationship with you through Adam.

2. Satan tempted Adam to break this covenant relationship.

3. Adam gave in to the temptation and made you a covenant-breaker with him.

4. But Jesus perfectly resisted temptation to make you a covenant-keeper in Him.

Hosea 6:7 ⁷ But like Adam they transgressed the covenant ... (ESV)

J.G. Vos "The tree of life symbolized not merely the life that man already possessed, but the highest kind of life to which man could ever attain; it symbolized what is called in the New Testament 'eternal life."

Revelation 12:9 9 So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world ... (NKJV)

R. Kent Hughes "According to the serpent, the threat of death was nothing more than a scare tactic to keep Adam and Eve in their place. God was repressive, and obviously jealous that they might ascend too high."

Derek Kidner "The pattern of sin runs right through the act, for Eve listened to a creature instead of the Creator, followed her impressions against her instructions, and made self-fulfillment her goal."

Richard Belcher "Sin leads to guilt, shame, and the loss of transparency."

R. Kent Hughes "Everything was upside-down. Eve followed the snake, Adam followed Eve, and no one followed God. The result was seismic ..."

Romans 5:12 ¹² Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned-- (NKJV)

Hebrews 4:15 ¹⁵ For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are, yet* without sin. (NKJV)
