- II. Works "fire shall try shall try every man's work" (vs. 12-15)

 - **B.** Rewarded "he shall receive a reward"
 - C. Regretted "work be burned he shall suffer loss"
- III. Worship "the Spirit of God dwells in you" (vs. 16-17)

 - A. Corporate "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God"
 - **B.** Cautioned "If any man defile the temple of God"
 - C. Consecrated "the temple of God is holy"
