- I. The advent season is a time for us to reflect on our Savior and our salvation - Savior is Shiloh.
- II. This is a prophecy that Jacob speaks to his sons before he dies, graciously promising that Christ will come from Judah's seed.

Until Shiloh Come

I. The High King

- A. This is God's promise to send an individual who will be our king (this is Jesus).

- B. Although we know Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of this prophecy, this one promise of God was fulfilled progressively through Scripture in Judah until Shiloh come.

II. The Outstanding Characteristic

- A. Shiloh reveals His rule and kingdom are characterized by peace and prosperity.

- B. As we reflect on the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ, in this advent season, may we remember that He has come to bring us spiritual peace and prosperity.

III. The Peacemaking Life

- A. Those who know Jesus Christ in truth as Shiloh, will live in peace with others - Rom. 12:18; Matt. 5:9.

- B. Are we living in peace with each other like we should? Are we peacemakers? Those who do this show they know Jesus in truth, as Shiloh.
