Discussion Questions

- 4. What does this passage say are some legitimate reasons not to ever get married?
- 5. What is meant in verse 29, "the appointed time has grown very short"?
- 6. What is mean in verse 31, "the present form of this world is passing away"?
- 7. If you are a Christian, how can you now live for what is eternal?
- 8. If you are not a Christian, how should this passage alarm you? Explain.

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

- 1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
- 2. What does each command in verses 29-31 mean?
- 3. How does the mindset taught in this passage differ from being indifferent to the things of this temporal, earthly life? How does it differ from seeking to escape the things of this life?
- 4. Do you normally have the eternal mindset that is taught in this passage? Explain.
- 5. What hinders you from having the eternal mindset taught in this passage? How can you overcome this?
- 6. How can you nurture the eternal mindset in your own life? How can you encourage others to have this mindset?
- 7. What is the primary way you should be affected by this sermon this week?
