INTRODUCTION:

1. PAUL POINTED THE GENTILE GALATIANS TO THE FAITH OF ABRAHAM THE FATHER OF THE JEWS (3:6).

- a. Abraham was a pagan idolater saved by faith (Jos 24:2).
- b. Likewise, those who believe the gospel are Abraham's children (3:17)
- 2. PAUL THEN DECLARES THAT ABRAHAM BELIEVED THE GOSPEL (3:8-9).
 - a. God's covenant promise to Abraham implied the gospel (3:8).
 - b. Paul concludes that Jew and Gentile believers are blessed with Abraham the believer (3:9).

3. APPLICATIONS:

- (1) The salvation of sinners is the good news of the forgiveness of sins and justification by imputed righteousness.
- (2) The salvation of sinners in the Old and New Testaments is always by God's grace.
- (3) The salvation of sinners brings them to the worship of the one, true, living God.
