In the Day of Trouble Habakkuk 3:16-19

Main Point:

In the day of trouble, exercise your faith in the LORD by resting, rejoicing, and relying.

1. In the day of trouble, rest in the LORD your God.

2. In the day of trouble, rejoice in the LORD your Savior.

3. In the day of trouble, rely upon the LORD your Strength.
