# Hope in the Midst of Defeat

## Introduction:

Today I want to trace the theme of God's promise of redemption to God's people through Scripture. Before we look at the first passage in Genesis 3:15 let's look at the context.

#### Genesis 3:15

And I will put enmity/hostility

Between you [the Serpent] and the woman [Eve],

And between your [Serpent's] seed and her [Eve's] seed;

He [the woman's seed] shall bruise you [Serpent] on the head,

And you shall bruise him [the woman's seed] on the heel."

Seed (offspring/descendant); is used both to describe the plural and singular offspring.

Seed of the serpent -

Cain (1John 3:10-13)

Religious Leaders of Jesus' day (John 8:44)

Judas (John 13:2, 10-11, 18, 26-27; 14:30)

The "Seed" theme is developed further through the offspring of the woman.

Seth (4:25)

Noah - Shem (9:25-29; 11:10-26)

Abram/Abraham (12:1-3; 13:14-17; 15:5-7; 17:1-8; 22:17-18

Isaac (21:12)

Jacob (28:14; 35:9-12)

Judah (49:8-12)

## The Seed Promise is fulfilled in Jesus Christ

Jesus (Matthew 1:1-17)

#### Galatians 3:16

Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as *referring* to many, but *rather* to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ.

# The Victory Promised is in Christ's life, death and resurrection.

# Hebrews 2:14-15, 16-18

14Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.

## Colossians 2:13-15

13When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, 14having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. 15When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him.
