**Philip Ryken** "God was taking Caesar's pawns and moving them to checkmate, so that the real Savior would stand alone as the King of kings."

**Micah 5:2** <sup>2</sup> "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting." (NKJV)

**Philip Ryken** "There was a reason that Christ humbled himself [in His birth]. He knew that in the end he could save us only by suffering and dying for our sins, and he wanted to show this from the very beginning. The humility of his birth was the whole pattern of his life."

**Isaiah 53:3** He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. (NKJV)

**John 6:38** <sup>38</sup> "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. (NKJV)

**Philippians 2:8** And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (ESV)

**Philip Ryken** "The sufferings that commenced with his incarnation culminated with his crucifixion. The same body that was wrapped in swaddling cloths was also wrapped in a burial shroud. The manger points us to the cross and to the grave. And this is how we are saved: by the humility of our Savior."

**Philippians 2:3-4** <sup>3</sup> Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. (ESV)
