- 1. Read **Colossians 4:3-4**. How confused and uninformed do you find the people you interact with to be about who Christ is and why he came? What are some of the strange ideas you have heard?
- 2. Read **Psalm 49:7-9**; **Isaiah 59:16** and **Matthew 20:28**. How does the human problem of sin, our inability to solve it or circumvent its eternal consequences, relate to the meaning of Christmas?
- 3. Read **John 1:9-14**. Why is it a good time to be more boldly evangelistic during the Christmas season? How can you make the most of the opportunities afforded by the cultural emphasis at Christmastime?
- 4. Read **1 Thessalonians 1:4-10**. How does this passage motivate you to understand Christ and the meaning and impact of his redemptive work better?
- 5. Read **Acts 1:6-11**. Why and in what ways should this promise empower and encourage you in the Christian life, even when the times are hard and our society gets increasingly more hostile to our message?
