I. GOD BECAME A MAN

John MacArthur

God became something He had never been without ceasing to be what He always was.

- A. THE NATURE OF JESUS' HUMANITY
- 1. Flesh

Incarnation the act of becoming flesh and blood

- cp. Hebrews 4:15
- 2. Dwelling Among Us

Point: Jesus is every bit human as we are, but without sin.

B. THE NATURE OF JESUS' DEITY

Jesus is unlike any other human to have ever lived.

Colossians 2:9

For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form

Deity

the quality of being God

Jesus is God.

1. John The Baptist, Greatest Of Men

Luke 7:28

I say to you, among those born of women there is no one greater than John; yet he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.

- a. Jesus is my superior
- b. Jesus came before me

Point: Jesus is the eternal God come to the earth as a human.

2. Moses, Greatest Of Religious Leaders

Deuteronomy 34:10

And there has not arisen a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face,

- a. Moses gave us the Law.
- b. Jesus gave us grace and truth.

Exodus 34:6, 7

Hebrews 3:3, 4

For He has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, by just so much as the builder of the house has more honor than the house. 4 For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God. Point: Jesus isn't just another religious leader, He is holy God.

II. MAN SEES GOD

B. JESUS HAS EXPLAINED GOD

a. To see Jesus is to see God's glory, v. 14

Glory

The expressed qualities of a person

"only son" or "only begotten

cp. Hebrews 11:17

b. To see Jesus is to see God

John 14:8, 9

c. To hear Jesus explain God is firsthand information

Hebrews 1:1-3

John 5:18; 10:33

? What about those of us who haven't physically seen Jesus?

1 John 1:1-3; John 20:29; Ephesians 1:18

-God's purpose is for His creation to know Him (Isaiah 11:9).

Habakkuk 2:14

-God's purpose is for us to know Him personally.

Jeremiah 9:23, 24

-But our sin blinds us and keeps us from knowing Him.

Ecclesiastes 3:11; Acts 17:23

2 Corinthians 4:3-6

Point: Jesus is our Creator come to bring us back into relationship with God by explaining His glory to us.
