Review Matthew 1:18-25.

- What does it mean to you that God is with us?
- How is Christmas hope different than Hallmark hope?
- How does the fact that God is with us give you hope during this season?



<u>Digging Deeper:</u> (Suggested Time 20 minutes)

Read Romans 5:1-8 and discuss the following questions.

- According to Paul, how is hope developed?
- Why does this hope not disappoint?
- Who is the hope based on and what did he do to give us hope?
- Ultimately, according to Paul, what is this hope looking forward to?

Application: (Suggested Time 10 minutes)

- There is no hope save for God Himself. Have you received His hope by trusting in Jesus, His death and resurrection?
- What promises of God can you put your hope in this Christmas season?
- In a world that is hungry for hope, who can you share hope with?
