Luke 12; Lord's Day 48 PRAYING FOR OUR FATHER'S KINGDOM

- I. The kingdom.
 - A. God reigns as Sovereign over all and forever.
 - B. The kingdom of God is the rule of God in Christ over subjects made willing in the day of the power of His grace.
 - 1. It is the rule of God because He planned, established, and realizes this rule by the power of His grace.
 - 2. It is called the kingdom of Christ because God establishes and exercises His rules through Christ.
 - 3. It is called the kingdom of heaven because it is spiritual, not earthly (John 18:36a).
 - C. We experience the kingdom when God's rule is recognized.
- II. The kingdom has a coming.
 - A. The kingdom comes through-out history.
 - B. At the Fall God promised the establishment of His kingdom in the spiritual seed of the woman.
 - 1. In Christ's perfect life and in His cross the basis of the kingdom was set in righteousness.
 - 2. At Christ's return, the kingdom of God will reach its completion and full development.
- III. We cannot make the kingdom come, but Jesus would have us pray for it.
 - A. Personally, we learn to desire to be so ruled by His Word and Spirit that we may submit ourselves more and more to Him.
 - B. Also, we are asking that God preserve and increase His church.
 - C. Therefore, we ask that God destroy the works of the devil and of all violence which exalts itself against our King.
 - D. And may the perfected kingdom come with the return of Jesus.
