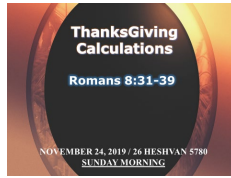

NOVEMBER 24, 2019 / 26 HESHVAN 5780 SUNDAY MORNING

ROMANS 8:31-39

- ³¹ What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? (KJV)
³¹ In view of all this, what can we say? If God is for us, who can be against us? (TEV)
- ³² He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? (KJV)
³² Certainly not God, who did not even keep back his own Son, but offered him for us all! He gave us his Son—will he not also freely give us all things? (TEV)
- ³³ Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth. (KJV)
³³ Who will accuse God's chosen people? God himself declares them not guilty! (TEV)
- ³⁴ Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. (KJV)
³⁴ Who, then, will condemn them? Not Christ Jesus, who died, or rather, who was raised to life and is at the right side of God, pleading with him for us! (TEV)
- ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (KJV)
³⁵ Who, then, can separate us from the love of Christ? Can trouble do it, or hardship or persecution or hunger or poverty or danger or death? (TEV)
- ³⁶ As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. (KJV)
³⁶ As the scripture says, "For your sake we are in danger of death at all times; we are treated like sheep that are going to be slaughtered." (TEV)
- ³⁷ Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. (KJV)
³⁷ No, in all these things we have complete victory through him who loved us! (TEV)
- ³⁸ For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, (KJV)
³⁸ For I am certain that nothing can separate us from his love: neither death nor life, neither angels nor other heavenly rulers or powers, neither the present nor the future, (TEV)
- ³⁹ Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (KJV)
³⁹ neither the world above nor the world below—there is nothing in all creation that will ever be able to separate us from the love of God which is ours through Christ Jesus our Lord. (TEV)

INTRODUCTION

The official Thanksgiving Day goes all the way back to 1789 when George Washington, the first President of the United States, proclaimed November 26th as a day of Thanksgiving. After that, Thanksgiving Day continued to be celebrated on different days in different states until finally in 1863, President Abraham Lincoln issued a White House proclamation calling on "the whole American people to observe a special day of Thanksgiving on **the last Thursday of November of every year.**" Ever since, each President has issued a Thanksgiving Day proclamation designating **the fourth Thursday of each November** as the official Thanksgiving Day.
