Hope and Silence

Malachi 3:1-5

In the cliffhanger of redemption, God has a story to tell that includes you and me. 1. The *Certainty* of Christ's Coming—God's people anticipated the Messiah's personal presence (3:1).

 God promised to send a forerunner to announce the arrival of the Messiah (3:1a).

• God promised to send the Messiah, the incarnation of God Himself (3:1b).

2. The *Characteristics* of Christ's Coming—God's people anticipated the Messiah's purifying power (3:2-4).

• The impurity of God's people was evident (3:2).

• The refinement of God's people was essential (3:2b-3a).

• The acceptance of God's people was expected (3:3b-4).

3. The *Consequences* of Christ's Coming—God's people anticipated the Messiah's perfect justice (3:5).

The Messiah will judge human injustice (3:5a).
The Messiah will judge heartless irreverence (3:5b).

4. The *Expectation* of Christ's Coming—God's people experienced an extended period of silence.

• Severe Oppression—Antiochus Epiphanes desecrated the Temple.

 Zealous Opposition—the Maccabees cleansed the Temple (Hannukah).

 Messianic Opportunity—reverent people waited for deliverance (Anna and Simeon). In the cliffhanger of redemption, God has a story to tell that includes you and me.
