Christians should spend at least some time determining what is being taught within the New Age. In the end, though, the messages are nothing more than lies because of their context.

Whether the message is provided to us by Kay Wheeler, Barbara Marciniak, or someone else entirely, the messages serve to alleviate the tremendous amount of stress that the average person will experience when the Rapture does occur.
