THE RESURRECTION DYNAMIC OF JESUS' FAITH: LIFE & DEATH INTRODUCTION

- 1. Jesus is *the author & perfector of faith* [Heb 12:2]. He is The Believer whose faith is the origin & culmination of our faith. We saw how faith in His Father's promises characterized Jesus at the point of the incarnation.
- 2. Tonite we continue our survey of Jesus as The Believer.

1st: Jesus the Believer as a Child

- 1. False gospels speculate about Jesus' childhood.
- 2. Luke informs us of visit to Jerusalem at 12 yrs old <u>Lk 2:46-52</u>
 - i. Jesus listening & asking questions & offering answers.
 - ii. People's *amazement* [rxn to display of deity]
 - a. understanding same term in Lk 24:45
 - **b.** *answers* teachers asking Jesus questions: how Jesus interpreted OT must have stunned them.

2nd: Jesus the Believer as the Fulfillment of OT Scripture

- 1. <u>Lk 24:46-47</u> Jesus' interpretation of the OT
- 2. He is the fulfillment of the promised suffering Messiah
- 3. He is the fulfillment of the promised resurrected Messiah Lk 20:41-44

3rd: Jesus the Believer Doing the Works of the Kingdom

- 1. Mat 17:14-21
 - i. why cldn't discs effect the miracle? unbelief [v17]; little faith [v20]
 - ii. what does that tell us re: how Jesus worked miracles? w/ faith
- 2. <u>Lk 7:20-23</u> Jesus assured JnB that He was fulfilling Scripture
- **3.** Look at Jesus & see the future. Life lived with eschatological significance the perfector of faith.

4th: Jesus the Believer Approaches Calvary Expecting to Rise Again

- 1. Faith's dynamic: cross to resurrection. Faith in God who raises the dead. Jesus' faith is expressed as He approaches Calvary, expecting the Father to raise Him from the dead.
- **2**. Lk 9:22; <u>Lk 18:31-33</u>

- 3. <u>Jn 13:1-4</u> Jesus knows He is about to return to Father. His prayer in Jn 17 is expectation of Father's promise to give HS in Messianic kingdom.
- 4. Prayer in Gethsemane expresses His *piety* [Heb 5:7]: manifest faith.

5th: Jesus the Believer Dies Believing

- 1. Mat 27:41-43 cross is ultimate test of Jesus' trust in God. Jesus is praying Ps 22:1 [v46]. He does trust in God & stays on the cross!
- 2. Lk 23:46 Jesus prays Ps 31:5 v6 I trust in the Lord
- **3**. Jn 19:30 *It is finished* [Ps 22:31]
- 4. Heb 12:2 why did Jesus stay on cross? for the joy set before Him

Applic #1: Do You Believe What Jesus Believed?

- 1. <u>Jn 11</u> Martha has orthodox, Abrahamic faith. Jesus is the God who gives life to the dead <u>Jn 11:21-27</u>
 - i. v21-22 Martha struggles to believe
 - ii. v23- 24 biblical orthodox hope of OT faith
 - iii. v25-26 Jesus is that hope: I am the resurrection & the life.
 - **a.** Do you believe what Jesus believed?
 - **b.** If we believe in Jesus, even tho we die the death of this age, we escape *the 2nd death* [Rv 20:14]
 - C. It all depends on whether or not we believe in Jesus
 - iv. v27 Martha's answer.

Applic #2: Ask Jesus to Strengthen Your Faith

- 1. Boy's father's faith mixed w/ unbelief Mrk 9:22b-24
 - i. v24 is faith mixed w/ unbelief? Go to author & perfector of faith!
 - ii. Jesus' answer exorcism = depiction of resurrection $\underline{v25-27}$
 - iii. We are given the resurrected Jesus.
- 2. It is encouraging to see Jesus as The Believer. Let us believe in Him & let us believe like Him.
