

## **The Legacy of Bob Jones, Sr.**

(October 30, 1883 – January 16, 1968)

The first few minutes of the presentation were accidentally not recorded. During that time, the speaker mentioned some of the resources on the life of Bob Jones, Sr. (see below), gave a brief outline of the presentation to come, referenced I Corinthians 11:1, and discussed Jones' birth into the multid denominational home of William Alexander and Georgia Creel Jones in Alabama (the 11<sup>th</sup> of 12 children). The recording picks up right after a discussion of Jones' brief attendance at two local schools and his father's instruction that he memorize Scripture and other works of literature to recite for visiting guests.
