Luke 1:39-80 Pastor Phil Winfield December 22, 2013

With the Filling of the Spirit:

- 1. John **leapt.** V.41
 - a. John was filled at his first **<u>encounter</u>** with Jesus.
 - b. Jesus was **<u>fully present</u>** and John reacted to Him in the first filling of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Elizabeth **<u>Blessed</u>** v.41-45
 - a. Elizabeth <u>cried out</u>! She lifted her voice in inspired utterance. Jn 1:15; <u>Jn 7:28</u>
 - *b.* Mary, You are an especially **blessed** woman because God has chosen you.
 - *c.* Mary, You are blessed because of the <u>child within you</u>.
 - d. Mary, you are blessed <u>because of your faith</u>. "blessed is she who believed." V.45.
- *3.* Mary **<u>Praised</u> v.46-55**
 - a. Her praise was personal v.46-49
 - *b.* Her praise is **projected forward**. V.50
 - *c.* Her praise was for **past faithfulness** v.51-53.
 - d. Her praise was for <u>fulfilled prophecy</u>. V.54-55. (Gen 12:1-3; Gen 15, 17; and especially Gen 22:17-18)
- 4. Zacharias **Prophesied**. V.67-79 "proclaimed"
 - a. He proclaimed **salvation**. V.68-75
 - *b.* He proclaimed the fulfillment of the **Davidic covenant** v.69
 - c. He proclaimed the fulfillment of the **Abrahamic Covenant**. V.70-75
 - *d.* He predicted that John will announce the **<u>New Covenant</u>**. V.76-79
- So what; Now what?
 - 1. You can <u>trust</u> your Bible.
 - You can believe God's promises <u>by faith</u>. It is more than that you must believe in order <u>to receive</u>.
 - 3. When you are filled with the Holy Spirit **you will speak**. (Eph. 5:18-20)
